PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

COMMERCIAL OFFER

Deliveries to Vietnam are planned mainly by sea and by air, the cost will depend on the volume of the shipment.

Black Horse will make all deliveries to Vietnam within 5-60 days, depending on each individual order.

As for order payment, Black Horse is planning to perform its activity on 100% prepayment and it will be possible to settle accounts in rubles and yuan.

Overview of the fermented dairy products market of Vietnam

- The fermented dairy products market in Vietnam was valued at approximately USD 276.8 million in 2021, and it is projected to grow at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of around 6% from 2023 to 2026.
- The most commonly consumed fermented dairy products in Vietnam are yogurt and kefir.
- Other fermented dairy products, such as sour cream, cottage cheese and cheese, have a much smaller market share in Vietnam.
- The average import duty rate is 0.1%-7%.
- Under the Free Trade Agreement for the EAEU countries, including Russia, duties on dairy products, kefir, cheese and cottage cheese are reduced to 0%.
- In 2021, Russia exported sour-milk products to Vietnam worth \$18 thousand.

Prospects for the export of Russian vegetable oil to Vietnam



Vietnam is one of the fastest-growing economies in Southeast Asia, with a large and growing population of over 97 million people.

Russia is one of the world's leading producers of vegetable oil, with a strong export capacity.

It is unlikely that Vietnam will be able to meet its growing demand for vegetable oil through domestic production alone, creating opportunities for imports from Russia.

Fish is the most popular type of seafood in Vietnam, accounting for 70% of total seafood consumption



The top seafood species consumed in Vietnam are shrimp, fish, squid, and crab




In 2020, Vietnam's seafood imports reached around \$1.6 billion
